

AFJH Stage Crew Safety Agreement

As you are aware, your student is currently enrolled in the stage crew class at American Fork Junior High. In an attempt to keep parents informed of all risks associated with the class, this form is to be read and signed by both parent and student before students may engage in any production or class activity. Please read the statement below carefully before signing and know that this school, and this district, consider this class — despite its inherent dangers, to be a valuable training ground towards achieving professional technical, problem solving, and time management skills. It also fosters an environment where students can be creative and learn to work well in a group. Furthermore, the instructor is trained in safety procedures for theatre and will be able to teach students how to safely participate in this class.

I am aware that participating in any technical theatre class can be a dangerous activity involving many risks of injury. I understand that the dangers and risks of participating in stage crew, both during class and preparing for a performance outside of class time, include working with manual and power tools, working upon and setting lights in the theatre, handling hot light fixtures, working with high wattage electrical equipment, building and moving sometimes tall and heavy set pieces, working on ladders, and performing backstage duties in near darkness. I understand the wisdom of my student bringing work gloves in which to perform any of the above duties. I also understand that AFJH/Mrs. King are not liable for any injury. Students, please read the following with your parents/guardians, initial each box, and sign below. This form will serve as a contract that signifies your agreement to fulfill these responsibilities. In addition, parents or guardians will sign to indicate knowledge of these responsibilities.

_____ I understand that there are a limited number of technical events over the course of the year and limited technical functions during events. Assignment of duties will be based on ability and trustworthiness to complete responsibilities associated to each assignment.

_____ I understand that assignment decisions are final and any changes only happen when one fails to fulfill contract.

_____ I promise to work hard, follow instructions, focus, and stay on task. I am committed to passing my other school classes so that I may participate in this class.

_____ I WILL ATTEND ALL REQUIRED AFTER-SCHOOL REHEARSALS, TECH REHEARSALS, DRESS REHEARSALS AND ALL ASSIGNED PERFORMANCES. I will be on time or a bit early.

_____ I agree to cooperate with all staff and students involved in the production.

_____ If I break this agreement I will be dismissed from participation in the show, and lose all associated points.

_____ If I have any concerns with an aspect of a production or tech event, I will set up a meeting to talk to Mrs. King myself and resolve the concern.

_____ I understand that this class is a privilege to be in and agree not to use this class as an excuse for not fulfilling other obligations, such as poor performance in other classes.

_____ I understand that I may be asked to use a variety of tools and equipment, including but not limited to power tools. There is an inherent risk associated with the use of many of these tools. I commit to practice safe work ethics and to NOT handle any tools, equipment, materials, etc. that I have not previously been trained on. The misuse and/or misconduct of such is grounds for immediate dismissal from this class.
